Part 2: Tools for the Task - Teacher Key

As a cranberry grower, you know how important technology is to helping you get your work done. Technology is anything created by people to help solve a problem – anything from a rake to a high tech electronic gadget. Here are some examples of the technologies that can be helpful to you as you go through your seasonal tasks.

Spring

- digital thermometer: protect buds from frost
 weeding tool, snippers, etc: pull early weeds
- o **vines:** renovate marshes, plant new vines

Summer

- rain gauge: irrigate cropsbee hives: rent bee hives
- o **pheromone "sticky" trap:** protect plants from insect pests

Autumn/Fall

- o water harvester (with water reel): harvest berries for cranberry products
- o mechanical raker: harvest fresh berries
- o **bounce machine, optical sorter:** sell the crop

Winter

- o **brush:** fix and build equipment
- o **computer, notebook, books:** attend special classes for growers
- o **marsh sander:** spread sand on marshes
